RESOLUTION NO. 032020

RESOLUTION INTRODUCING LOCAL LAW NO. 3 OF THE YEAR 2020, AMENDING CHAPTER A154, RECREATION FEES OF THE CODE OF THE VILLAGE OF WAPPINGERS FALLS

The following resolution was introduced by Trustee Poanessa and seconded by Trustee Davis

WHEREAS, the Village Board of Trustees made a determination that it was

necessary to undertake a study of recreation needs to enable the Village to improve lands

suitable for meeting the Village's current and future residents' recreational needs and requested the firm of Four Corners Planning to undertake such a study; and

WHEREAS, after review and due consideration of the Recreation Needs Assessment study, the Board of Trustees has determined that it would be in the best interests of the residents to adopt a Local Law decreasing the recreation fees at this present time and adding a provision that future amendments to recreation fees may be made by Resolution duly adopted by the Village Board of Trustees; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees has determined that pursuant to 6 NYCRR 617.5 (c) (20) the proposed adoption of the aforementioned Local Law is a Type II action not requiring environmental review pursuant to State Environmental Quality Review Act (SEQRA) and, accordingly, no environmental review has been undertaken.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

- The Village Board of Trustees hereby introduces for consideration of its adoption proposed "Local Law No. 3 of the Year 2020, Amending Chapter A154, Recreation Fees of the Code of the Village of Wappingers Falls", in the form annexed hereto.
- 2. The Village Board of Trustees hereby schedules a Public Hearing regarding the proposed adoption of the annexed Local Law for 7:00 P.M., on the 12 day of March 2020, to be held at Village Hall, 2582 South Avenue, Wappingers Falls, New York, and the Village Clerk is directed to post the Notice of Public Hearing in the form annexed hereto and to publish same in the newspaper as required by law.
