#### **Other Projects and Assignments**

#### • Village / Utility Improvement Contract 5

- Contract 5 scope includes water connection improvements from Village of Wappingers Falls to the Town of Wappinger on Losee Road (funded by Village DWSRF #18830) and Route 9 Sewer (sewer funds) work not completed near Dutchess Plaza and Arrow Auto Glass during Contract 4.
- Design was submitted in Nov 2020 for agency reviews to NYS and Dutchess County Health Departments, Dutchess County DPW, and NYSDOT for Route 9.
- Bidding is targeted for early 2021 in preparation for 2021 construction.
- Public Meeting for VWF Contract 5 Design needs scheduled

#### Village / Water Filter Building and Facilities

- In late spring 2020, KC and the Village prepared and submitted a USDA Engineering Report in support of a Village funding application for the proposed Water Filter Building and Facilities at the Water Supply Facility.
- In early 2020, KC completed Preliminary Design for the Water Filter Building and Facilities.
- In Dec 2020, the Village Water Board authorized KC to prepare Final Design for the Water Filter Building and Facilities.

#### Village / Wenliss Water Tank Replacement

• In Dec 2020, the Village Water Board authorized KC to prepare Preliminary Design for the Wenliss Water Tank Replacement.

#### • Village / Grease Trap Engineering Planning Grant

- Work on the Grease Trap Engineering Planning Grant project continues. Project Committee met August 28, 2020. This is a two-year grant.
- Work is nearly ready for submitted to the Village and then to NYSEFC.

#### Village / Bain Park Survey and Masterplan

- Completed survey mapping has been transmitted to the Village.
- KC remotely attended the Oct 20, 2020 Bain Park Public Meeting.
- KC facilitated a Design Kickoff Meeting at the Bain Park site on Nov 6, 2020.
- During winter, KC Engineering will provide the following work:
  - Conceptual Master Plan for Bain Park;
  - Site Design for Playground Equipment Area; and
  - Long Form Part 1 EAF.

#### • Village / EPA Grant Brownfield Assessments

 Next Steps – Phase 2 Assessments – Bleachery pending EPA approval of material submitted.

## RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING WAIVER OF PENALTY FOR LATE WATER PAYMENTS DUE TO COVID-19 PANDEMIC

**WHEREAS,** the worldwide COVID-19 pandemic poses a threat to the health and welfare of the residents and visitors of the State of New York, County of Dutchess and the Village of Wappingers Falls; and

**WHEREAS,** on March 7, 2020, Governor Cuomo issued an Executive Order, declaring a State of Emergency for the entire State of New York, which has been extended; and

WHEREAS, the COVID-19 pandemic has caused economic upheaval which has made it difficult for residents and businesses in the Village of Wappingers Falls to pay their financial obligations, including water bills; and

**WHEREAS,** § 148-18 of the Code of the Village of Wappingers Falls assesses a late penalty of 5% on all water and sewer charges that have been in arrears for more than thirty (30) days; now, therefore

**BE IT RESOLVED,** that the Village Board hereby authorizes the suspension of the late penalty assessment imposed by § 148-18 during the pending Statewide State of Emergency for the COVID-19 pandemic.
