and these are some of the uh the things

that have come out of that

so let's look further into what water

0:09:36.000,0:09:38.560

and infrastructure

has been improved and of course what

0:09:38.560,0:09:43.200

still needs improvement

0:09:41.120,0:09:44.399

so in december of 2006 the village had

0:09:43.200,0:09:46.959

no drinking water

0:09:44.399,0:09:48.720

and had to purchase 100 of it from an

0:09:46.959,0:09:51.440

outside source

0:09:48.720,0:09:52.480

we quickly organized to build a 5.7

0:09:51.440,0:09:56.000

million dollar

0:09:52.480,0:09:58.640  
water treatment facility and in 2013

0:09:56.000,0:10:00.959  
we added solar power to make it 100

0:09:58.640,0:10:02.640  
solar powered

0:10:00.959,0:10:04.240  
some streets would have as many as seven

0:10:02.640,0:10:06.800  
water main breaks a year

0:10:04.240,0:10:08.240  
over the next 14 years we replaced four

0:10:06.800,0:10:10.399  
miles of water main

0:10:08.240,0:10:13.360  
and obviously as you can see here the

0:10:10.399,0:10:15.120  
red is what it used to be

0:10:13.360,0:10:16.720  
the blue is what has been updated since

0:10:15.120,0:10:18.480  
then

0:10:16.720,0:10:20.320  
there's still some very important water

0:10:18.480,0:10:21.040  
projects to do and the village has a

0:10:20.320,0:10:24.000  
pros

0:10:21.040,0:10:25.600  
approached the federal usda funding and

0:10:24.000,0:10:26.160  
the state's drinking water revolving

0:10:25.600,0:10:28.079  
fund

0:10:26.160,0:10:30.560  
with the request for these remaining

0:10:28.079,0:10:32.320  
purchases

0:10:30.560,0:10:33.920  
we have a major investment in sewer

0:10:32.320,0:10:35.839  
treatment as well replacing the pump

0:10:33.920,0:10:36.880  
station for the entire village and town

0:10:35.839,0:10:39.360  
of wappinger

0:10:36.880,0:10:41.600  
and here is an aerial view of said pump

0:10:39.360,0:10:43.519  
station

0:10:41.600,0:10:44.720  
we went on to replace five miles of

0:10:43.519,0:10:46.720  
sewer lines

0:10:44.720,0:10:48.399  
the 100 year old lines were obviously

0:10:46.720,0:10:51.200  
letting a lot of groundwater in

0:10:48.399,0:10:51.920  
due to being outdated major upgrades are

0:10:51.200,0:10:54.560  
still needed

0:10:51.920,0:10:56.320  
at the shared sewer plant and three

0:10:54.560,0:10:57.360  
municipalities are requesting funding

0:10:56.320,0:10:59.760  
from the state's

0:10:57.360,0:11:01.200  
clean water evolving fund as previously

0:10:59.760,0:11:03.120  
said



0:11:01.200,0:11:04.800  
expanding this plant will spread costs

0:11:03.120,0:11:06.399  
over a larger number of users

0:11:04.800,0:11:08.959  
and it will also enable us to

0:11:06.399,0:11:12.320  
decommission upstream sewer plants

which will inevitably improve the water

0:11:12.320,0:11:14.640  
lake water quality

so it's a little bit of a snowball

effect uh of course all of these water

0:11:19.120,0:11:22.480  
lines required that we dig up streets

0:11:20.720,0:11:24.399  
sidewalks and curbs

and so that required us to replace the

0:11:24.399,0:11:28.880  
infrastructure which meant we were given

0:11:26.079,0:11:30.720  
the village a new facelift with almost

0:11:28.880,0:11:31.680  
10 miles of newly paved streets these

0:11:30.720,0:11:33.440  
new streets

0:11:31.680,0:11:35.120  
have seen a dramatic improvement in the

0:11:33.440,0:11:38.399  
way properties

0:11:35.120,0:11:40.720  
have been maintained we

0:11:38.399,0:11:41.440  
understand however that not every street

0:11:40.720,0:11:44.480  
has been

0:11:41.440,0:11:45.680  
attacked yet some of the lesser used or

0:11:44.480,0:11:47.760  
shorter roads still

need improvement some more than others

0:11:47.760,0:11:50.720  
we do want people to know that that is

0:11:49.360,0:11:53.920  
still

0:11:50.720,0:11:53.920  
on the list for things to do

all of the past improvements to water

0:11:57.040,0:12:00.240  
and sewer which totaled roughly 35

0:11:59.120,0:12:01.760  
million dollars

have been supported with almost 10

0:12:01.760,0:12:05.760  
million in grants and

0:12:03.440,0:12:07.519  
10 million and forgiven interests

0:12:05.760,0:12:09.760  
however it has left the village with the

0:12:07.519,0:12:12.000  
need to regularly

0:12:09.760,0:12:13.920  
increased rates by three percent a year

0:12:12.000,0:12:16.800  
as it was determined in 2012

0:12:13.920,0:12:18.320  
when these large projects began the

0:12:16.800,0:12:20.160  
village has also studied the need for

0:12:18.320,0:12:21.760  
drainage and developed a list of needed

0:12:20.160,0:12:23.760  
drainage improvements

0:12:21.760,0:12:25.120  
they are first and foremost oak park

0:12:23.760,0:12:28.000  
which needs to be drained

0:12:25.120,0:12:29.440  
to the ecosystem and down behind the

0:12:28.000,0:12:31.360  
lake and brookside

uh east and west main streets both of

0:12:31.360,0:12:34.560  
course have needs

0:12:33.200,0:12:36.880  
require help from the department of

0:12:34.560,0:12:39.839  
transportation since it's part of

0:12:36.880,0:12:40.560  
route 9d and adams street and goring

0:12:39.839,0:12:43.680  
place are

also both in need water quality in the

0:12:43.680,0:12:45.839  
village for both recreation and water

is in desperate need of remediation 37

miles of watershed from 12 other

remediation we have a non-element plan

that is a public thing you can read the

water characterization report

it's over 500 pages long but it is chock

0:13:07.360,0:13:11.839  
full of really good information

dredging however is the main thing we

0:13:11.839,0:13:16.480  
can do to remediate this

however dredging is extremely expensive

and the village has

actively looking to different ways we

can successfully dredge the lake

while making it affordable for the

but moving on to our parks some major

they received over 1.2 million dollars

the first of which is the boathouse

box factory which had most recently been

our highway garage

until 2013. it was repurposed to be a

boathouse community center

that focuses on youth arts and boating

and this is planned to be finished up

late this year or early next year

frannie reese park will finish up this

fall and provide lakefront access

it will have an outdoor entertainment

space with the lakeside amphitheater

shown on the left uh that's it in

progress and on the right we see the

cobbler shop which i'm sure many people

as they drive up west main street the

0:14:28.480,0:14:32.880  
very small building

0:14:30.320,0:14:34.800  
at the parking lot of franny reese the
